
PSYCHOLOGICAL ASPECTS OF REPRODUCTIVE HEALTH

Therefore, measures for improvement of reproductive health of adolescents, for healthy motherhood and infertility problem solving are significant elements of strategic activities in developed countries with the aim to achieve simple replacement of generations. 

The participants of the ECPD International Summer School will obtain the course materials necessary for effective attendance of the School. Authorized presentations will be published in Proceedings.


School Certificate

- **127 EUR** for a double room (night and breakfast for two persons)


